WHITE WINE

101LW Organic Macabeo, Castaño, Murcia, Spain ^{Ve V O S} 2018 £4.25 / £5.50 / £7.50 £22

The Macabeo Organic wine is clear and shiny, which shows a pale yellow colour as well as fresh pleasant notes of white fruit such as apple and citrus. On the palate it is soft with a lifted finish.

102LW Viognier IGP Côtes de Thau, Baron de Badassière, Languedoc, France ^{Ve V} 2018 - £24

This Viognier is made in a fresh, modern style. It offers subtle aromas of almond and honey on the nose. Rounded on the palate, with guava and apricot flavours, it is balanced by a refreshing acidity on the finish.

103LW Western Cape Fairtrade Chenin Blanc, Liberty Fairtrade, South Africa ^{O V} 2019 - £25

Delicate aromas of tropical fruit and guavas carry through to the palate. This wine has fresh acidity and a medium-long finish.

104TH Pinot Grigio, Carlo Damiani Fabiano, Valpolicella, Italy 2016 £5 / £6.50 / £9 £28

This is a typical Pinot Grigio with a brilliant straw yellow colour, with a delicate bouquet of white acacia blossom, apricots and peaches, with more white orchard fruits on the palate. Natural acidity balances the subtle fruit flavours providing a gentle but lengthy finish.

105LW Chardonnay, 16 Stops, Adelaide, South Australia ^{Ve V} 2018 £5 / £6.50 / £9 £28

Fresh and elegant, this wine has good fruit weight and aromas including apple and white peach, a lovely texture and a savoury, mealy edge. The acidity is nicely balanced, giving the wine good length on the finish.

106LW Vinho Verde, Quinta de Azevedo, Portugal ^V 2017 - £30

This is a crisp, light and fresh wine made from Loureiro and Pedernã grapes in the Vinho Verde region of northern Portugal. This is deliciously fresh and fruity with attractive citrus notes and a crisp apple skin character. Perfect to drink on its own it would also match well with fresh seafood.

109LW Sauvignon Blanc, Tinpot Hut, Marlborough, New Zealand ^{Ve V} 2017 £6 / £8 / £11.50 £35

A complex and elegant wine with intense aromas of blackcurrant, crushed lemongrass and thyme, mingle with passionfruit and melon highlights. On the palate, underlying ripe fruit and mineral notes. A stylish and pleasingly rich Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc with vibrant aromatics and a fine balance of acidity leading to a lingering finish.

111LW Gavi di Gavi, Terre Antiche, Piemonte, Italy^{Ve V} 2018 - £41

This crisp white wine shows incredible mineral, zesty and floral notes, with a hint of spice and the typical hints of bitter almond that makes this wine unique. Prominent mineral characters linger on the long and precise finish.

115LW Sancerre, Domaine des Brosses, Loire, France 2017 - £49

Bright and pale golden. A fresh, citrus palate has herbaceous notes of hay and nettle. Richly textured but with crisp acidity and textbook minerality. The finish is elegant with typical purity and refreshment of excellent Sancerre.

116TH Pouilly Fume, Domaine Bruno Blondelet, Loire, France^V 2017 - £55

Bruno Blondelet's Pouilly Fumé is a lovely, complex wine with classic gooseberry and green apple aromas and flavours but also with hints of tangerines and nectarines. There is a touch of flintiness, a little like wet stones. Like a good Sancerre this is a pretty, elegant Sauvignon Blanc. There is a very light creaminess to the wine veering towards a medium body but the wine is essentially light and refreshingly crisp as you would expect.

117TH Chablis Domaine de Malandes, Burgundy, France^V 2017 - £58

A good vintage for Chablis. Crisp Chablis with aromas of fresh fruit, particularly peaches, and a richness together with that classic minerality. Ideal as an aperitif or with simple fish dishes.

120TH Puligny-Montrachet, David Moret, Burgundy, France 2014 - £80

Pale golden hues in the glass. With zesty citrus aromas, this Chardonnay is generous on the palate with spicy undertones and a lingering finish. Delicious and complex, it is difficult to find a white wine quite like it outside of Burgundy.

	Castaño Monastrell Ecológico is an organic red wine from the D.O. Yecla produced by the Castaño winery. This wine is made exclusively with the Monastrell grape variety, the most cultivated variety in the region. Intense red morello cherry and spiced fruits. Silky and fruity.			
302LW	Robertson Cabernet Sauvignon, Excelsior, Breede River Valley, South Africa	2017	-	£23
	A round and vibrant Cabernet Sauvignon with plum and strawberry flavours combined with hints of red pepper and spice. The palate is smooth and well balanced, with a fruity and long-lasting finish.			
303LW	Merlot, Montes Classic Series, Colchagua Valley, Chile	2018	£5 ^{.50} / £6 ^{.75} / £9	£25
	This deep ruby coloured Merlot offers a variety of fresh red fruit aromas including raspberry, cherry and plum. French oak is evident, with notes of vanilla and nutmeg, as well as a hint of caramel. The palate is nicely balanced, with very subtle tannins, a good structure and a long finish.			
306LW	El Coto, Rioja Crianza, Rioja, Spain	2015	-	£28
	The nose is fresh and pronounced with excellent fruit concentration. The palate is clean and well balanced, with a core of strawberry fruit combined with subtle vanilla flavours from American oak. The finish is juicy and long.			
305LW	Malbec Mendoza, Kaiken Reserve, Argentina ^{Ve} ^V	2017	£5 ^{.75} / £7 / £11	£32
	Deep purple in colour. Dried fruit aromas of strawberries and cherries are nicely complemented with spicy notes and menthol aromas. On the palate this wine displays extraordinary balance, freshness and soft tannins.			
308TH	Pinot Noir, Les Argelieres, Grande Cuvee Spéciale, Languedoc, France	2017	£6 / £8 / £11 ^{.50}	£35
	Glossy garnet red in the glass, on the nose there are aromas of raspberry and cherry with subtle smoky and peppery hints, Fruity, elegant and well-balanced on the palate with a silky long finish.			
311LW	McLaren Vale Shiraz/Viognier, Willunga 100, South Australia	2016	-	£37
	This is a rich and luscious wine with lifted aromatics, dark black berry fruit and supple tannins. Well-structured wine, deep purple in colour, on the nose, there are notes of plum, chocolate and cedar. The palate is rich and luscious with ripe black fruits harnessed by silky texture and supple tannins.			

317_{LW} 'Palazzo della Torre', Allegrini, Veneto, Italy ^{Ve V} 2015 - £47

Ruby red in colour, Palazzo della Torre has enticing aromas of cherry with rich dark chocolate notes. Velvety in texture, it is well-balanced and offers ripe, juicy dark fruit, with silky tannins and refreshing acidity.

319_{LW} Chianti Classico, Fontodi, Tuscany, Italy ^o 2016 - £52

The 2016 Chianti Classico Fontodi brings together all the elements that make the Fontodi wines so unique, but with an extra kick of freshness and aromatic intensity that is the result of a year with notable diurnal shifts during the growing season. Dark blue/purplish fruit, lavender, spice and menthol develop in the glass, but it is the wine's extraordinary balance and sheer appeal that stand out most.

320_{TH} Chateau Grand Lartigue Grand Cru Saint Emilion, France ^V 2012 - £58

The soils of the former floodplain of the Dordogne River are rich in sand and clay, producing a very different style of wine to the vines planted on limestone, generally more generous and more accessible. The Vieux Lartigue is a classic example, with sumptuous black cherry fruit, some smoky grilled notes behind and a lovely supple finish - we cannot recommend this highly enough.

321_{LW} 'Closierie de Vaudieu' Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Château de Vaudieu, Southern Rhône, France ^{VVe} 2015 - £65

Chateau de Vaudieu is one of the older estates in Chateauneuf du Pape. The beautiful, classic chateau was built in 1767. Chateau de Vaudieu is not only one of the oldest estates in the Southern Rhone Valley, they were also one of the first to export their wine to other markets. A stunning example of what this well known region does so well - berry, liquorice and black pepper on the nose, ripe tannins with cassis and herb character to finish.

323_{TH} Margaux Private Reserve, Bordeaux, France ^S 2014 - £80

This wine is part of the Private Reserve range. It is made in the image of its well-known appellation, with fruity bouquet, velvety and round structure. Deep and bright colour. Fruity bouquet, a wine both velvety and pleasant. Great with red meat and cheese.

202LW	'Terre di Monteforte' Pinot Grigio Rosato, Cantina di Monteforte, Veneto, Italy ^{Ve V S}	2018	£5 / £6 ^{.50} / £9	£26
	This wine is a lovely salmon-pink colour with delicate perfumes of red cherries and strawberries. The palate is dry and intense with lingering strawberry hints on the finish.			
203LW	'Estérelle' Côtes de Provence, Château du Rouët, France	2018	-	£38
	This wine is pale salmon in colour with aromas of strawberry and raspberry, coupled with notes of wild thyme and rosemary. The palate is dry with refreshing acidity and the finish is long and scented.
